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# Northwest Pilot Project

“Pathways” support from HUD

- Part of our CoC Application
- Also called Rapid Re-housing

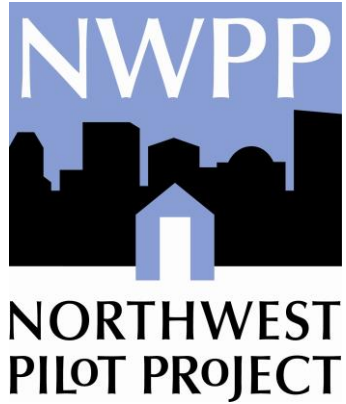


- PATHWAYS
  - Clients must be on Coordinated Access
  - High demand
  - Up to 24 months of rent assistance
  - Priorities
    - Households (HH) assessed as inappropriate for emergency shelter – chronic/acute medical needs
    - HH below 20% MFI
    - HH with fewest immediate housing options
    - HH approved for housing but no financial resources

- Must meet HUD definition of homelessness (not chronic homeless)
- Must be eligible for NWPP services
- Score a 15 or lower on VI-SPDAT
- Able to live independently
- Must agree to meet regularly with NWPP housing staff to work on a housing plan

# ELIGIBILITY





## Next Steps

- Client is enrolled in the program
- Client and NWPP housing staff meet regularly
- Rent assistance paid
- Work together on long-term housing plan
- Follow-up support

# CLIENT CASELOAD

- FY 2022-23
- About \$240K per FY
- 45 – 50 clients per year
- Move to permanent housing within 24-month period
